Overview of Health Insurance

Old Business:

- <u>Facility Update:</u> Chief Stein, Chief Givens and M Anderson met with Greenleaf staff on 12/4 to discuss revised floor plans. Adjustments were made to the plans to match the budget. FD team will review plans and get back with GL. The project estimate was briefly discussed which will lead to additional research and further discussions with GL.
- New Appointees: Chief Stein will secure a resume from a potential candidate.

New Business:

- Public Notice of Intent to Call an Election: Notice was read by S Stewart and is attached.
- <u>2025 Chairman Election:</u> Motion made by S Slifer to re-appoint M Anderson as 2025 Chair, seconded by J King and was unanimously approved. B Brenner submitted a motion to re-appoint S Slifer as 2025 Vice Chair, seconded by J King and was unanimously approved.
- <u>2024 Financial Status & Capital Funds</u>: Deferred to January meeting once all year end transactions are completed.
- <u>Incentive Pay Plan</u>: Chief Stein is gathering input from all FD team and will finalize by January 1,
 2025
- PT Training Officer: Chief Stein had conversation with a training officer available for hire in January. He has 30 years' experience in fire/EMS with 20 years' experience in training and would be a great addition to the staff that would increase in-house training and could result in improvements of our PIAL rating. Because this position was not specifically identified in the 2025 budget, a motion to add the PT training officer @ approximately \$29,000 annually was submitted by S Slifer, seconded by J King and unanimously approved.
- <u>Chief Stein's Annual Review</u>: Review forms were distributed to all board members. M Anderson requested the completed forms returned to him prior to the January meeting.
